We review every application we receive. We evaluate each applicant holistically. We don't select applicants based on any

single criterion. All criteria are considered as part of our review of the whole person. Criteria of our holistic review, in no particular order: successful completion of Ohio State's minimum college prep requirements; high school performance (class rank or GPA), including participation in accelerated programs like Honors, AP, and IB; standardized test score (ACT or SAT); ability and desire to contribute to and engage with a diverse campus community; experiences that demonstrate leadership or engaged involvement; status as a first-generation college student, demonstration of outstanding talent in a particular area; and high school performance if adversely affected by physical, mental or learning environment factors
