SELECTION CRITERIA FOR FALL TERM:

High school students must submit an official high school transcript indicating cumulative GPA along with ACT or SAT scores to be considered for admission.

Based on Wright State's liberal admission policy, students who have completed the Ohio Core curriculum, earned a 2.0 or higher cumulative GPA, and a minimum of a 15 ACT composite (740 SAT combined critical reading and math) will be granted admission. Students who have completed the Ohio Core curriculum, earned a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA, and submit ACT or SAT scores will be granted admission.
