SELECTION CRITERIA FOR FALL TERM:

Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and a 17 ACT composite (910 SAT combined Evidence-based Writing and Reading test score and Math score) for unconditional admission. Applicants not meeting these requirements may be considered on a conditional basis. Entering students may be required to take a reading, writing, and math placement test.
